Pittsburgh Theological Seminary and Presbyterian College are pleased to announce a partnership designed to educate and equip students by combining their undergraduate education with a master's degree program. The partnership, designed to provide a seamless transition between the undergraduate and seminary contexts, will allow students to earn both a bachelor's and master's degree of their choice at the Seminary in five or six years. PTS offers three master's degrees that will be available to PC undergraduate students: master of theological studies (3+2), master of arts in pastoral studies (3+2), and master of divinity (3+3).
