

## STUDENT RECEIVES AWARD FOR DOCTORAL STUDIES



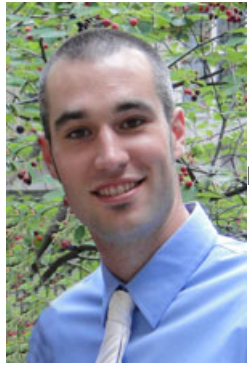
Pittsburgh Theological Seminary senior Master of Divinity student Charles Cotherman is the recipient of a

Jefferson Fellowship, a highly competitive scholarship for doctoral work at the University of Virginia.

Established in 1980 as a prominent merit-based scholarship program, the fundamental mission of the Jefferson Scholars Foundation is to identify, attract, and nurture individuals of extraordinary intellectual range and depth who possess the highest qualities of leadership, scholarship, and citizenship. Cotherman competed with 49 other Graduate School of Arts and Sciences applicants to receive one of only a dozen Jefferson Fellowships awarded by the school this year. As a Jefferson Fellow, Cotherman will receive a full tuition scholarship for up to five years, an annual stipend, and additional research funds over the course of his program.
