


# THE ART OF TRANSITIONAL MINISTRY, PART 2

# GUIDING A CONGREGATION THROUGH CHANGE AND TRANSITION

## WHAT?

The basic education program for Transitional Ministry explores the unique dynamics of the congregation during a change in pastoral leadership or other significant transition. It equips the transitional/interim pastor with knowledge, analytical skills, and practical approaches needed to help the congregation use this opportunity as a time for renewal.



## WHO?

The basic education program is designed for persons engaged in transitional/interim ministry, clergy who are considering ministry in transitional settings, and members of Presbytery

staffs, Commissions on Ministry, and comparable representatives from other denominations than the PC(USA). Participants in Part 2 of the Transitional Ministry Training must 1) be currently serving in a transitional ministry, and 2) have completed Part 1 of basic training. Please provide a copy of your certificate of completion for Week 1 training with your registration form.

All sessions are held at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary. Limited overnight housing is available on campus. Additional housing is available at local hotels (listings will be provided upon request). ## SCHEDULE / REGISTRATION / ADVANCE PREPARATION
