TEXTILE ART

Sara Trail learned to sew at the young age of 4, and is now a successful author, sewing teacher, and pattern and fabric designer. While attending UC Berkeley, Sara created a quilt in memory of Trayvon Martin, and her love for sewing and passion for social justice intertwined. After graduating from the Harvard University Graduate School of Education, she founded the Social Justice Sewing Academy (SJSA). As Founder of SJSA, Sara actively travels to facilitate lectures and workshops. She is also key in developing and implementing the artistic vision of the organization.â

PAINTING AND PUBLIC ART Jasmine Green is a Black visual artist born and raised in Pittsburgh, Pa. Jasmine strives to create artwork that tells the story of Black womer creative ways as possible.
