## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This advanced course is designed to help students develop or deepen such pastoral care and counseling skills as listening, assessing, responding, referring, and intervening in crisis situations, with special attention to the congregational context. Students will learn to differentiate the pastoral roles and tasks unique to providing pastoral care, pastoral counseling, and spiritual counsel, and the relationships among them.

## **CLASS OBJECTIVES:**

By the end of this course students will:

- 1. Develop and deepen communication skills for ministry, including listening, assessing, responding, intervening, and referring in both typical and crisis situations.
- 2. Demonstrate the ability to discern and respond appropriately to deeper patterns embedded in personal life stories (including one's own) and communal narratives.
- 3. Develop capacity to reflect theologically on the importance of pastoral listening and communication, and articulate biblical and theological foundations for listening ministry.
- 4. Strengthen their identities as pastoral caregivers by refining the capacity for self-awareness and reflection.
