THE M.A.P.S. AT PTS

The Master of Arts in Pastoral Studies (M.A.P.S.) is a flexible, two-year degree hybrid program that equips students for congregational ministry careers and pastoral positions in other settings. The MA in Pastoral Studies curriculum provides flexibility for students to define a ministry-oriented course of study and to learn in their current context and in Pittsburgh.

The pastoral studies program provides grounding in core disciplines and the ability for a student to select from a variety of ministerial electives to suit their interests and vocational needs.

To complete the Pastoral Studies program, each graduate student learns to illuminate Scripture, Christian history, and theology to their ministerial context and completes the degree with a year of field education and a final project. To customize their pastoral ministry degree, students can pursue the Graduate Certificate in Urban Ministry.

ABOUT THE MASTER'S IN PASTORAL STUDIES

The Pastoral Studies hybrid degree program can be completed on a part- or full-time basis with day and evening classes available. Because the program is hybrid, students will complete courses online, on campus, and in their context.

A low student-to-faculty ratio fosters close interaction with dedicated scholars and mentoring teachers to fully prepare students for the joys and challenges of ministry.

With our connections to local ministry opportunities and the largest theological library in the tri-state area, Pittsburgh Theological Seminary offers unmatched resources for students to begin their journey to a fulfilling career in Christian ministry.

In addition to cross-registration opportunities at local colleges and universities, Pittsburgh Seminary students have the option to earn a **joint law degree through Duquesne**University alongside their pastoral ministry degree.
